Auxiliary Units

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The following passenger compartment heater system components may be subject to replacement, adjustment or repair:

- central knob (1) for selecting passenger compartment ventilation fan speeds;
- front support (5) of control mount;
- passenger compartment ventilation fan;
- resistor for passenger compartment ventilation fan speeds
- control mount with knobs;
- passenger compartment ventilation fan speed selector switch;
- air intake control cable:
- mixer flap control cable;
- distribution flap control cable;
- heater distributor assembly;
- heater radiator.

To service the parts listed above (except the first four and cable adjustment) carry out the various operations described below and on the following pages in order to remove the instrument facia.


Detail of central console without front panel









- unscrew screws (17) that retain control panel (18) to the instrument facia after removing panel from its seat and disconnecting the various connectors (19) from behind.;




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
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
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







- unscrew the three hexagonal headed socket screws (arrowed in the top figure) located under the moulding and the above grilles that fasten top of facia to body;
- unscrew screw (22) and after opening flap (23) giving access to the junction box, unscrew screw (24) that fastens sides of the middle part of the left hand end of the facia to the body;
- open cover (25) of glove compartment and unscrew screw (arrowed in the right hand figure) that fastens side of the middle part of the right hand end of the facia to the body;








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


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
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- NOTE The operations described and illustrated on this page are reserved solely for vehicles with top tunnel trim.
- remove box cover (1) of radio compartment, followed by plate (2) and plug (3) (noting that the latter is hinged at the rear) that are located on the rear part of the tunnel trim;
- unscrew screws (4) that fasten top part (5) of tunnel trim to underlying bottom part (6) and trim of central console (7);
 - release top trim (5) from bottom trim (6), noting that side ridges of central part of first part are inserted in arrowed seats;
 - working from underneath the top trim (5) undo tabs of frame retaining bottom of cone trim (8) protecting gear lever in order to release;
 - unscrew nuts (9) retaining tunnel rear trim (10) and rear part of front lower trim (6) to the vehicle floor pan;
 - unscrew bolts (11) that fasten tunnel bottom front trim (6) to trim of central console (8);
 - lift rear trim (10) and remove lower front trim (6);



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




AIR INTAKE FLAP CONTROL CABLE


To replace the air intake flap control cable (A), proceed as follows:

- unscrew screw (1) that fastens terminal (3) of sheath of cable (A) to control support;
- remove retaining washer (4) and withdraw spiral at the end of cable (A) from cylindrical ridge on lever (5);





- release (by pulling upward) the other end of the sheath of cable (A) from metal clip (6) inserted in block (7) press-fitted to left side surface of heater-distributor assembly fan assembly;
- withwraw spiral from the other end of the cable from the cylindrical ridge on air intake flap idler lever (8).




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


To refit the new cable, carry out removal operations in reverse order, noting that the end of the sheath without the terminal must be inserted in metal clip (6) so that the air intake flap can move through its entire travel.


NOTE To correct position of cable sheath, which is necessary when air intake flap opening or closure is defective, the instrument facia need not be removed because the repair can be carried by working from the bottom right in the middle.

- unscrew screw (1) that fastens terminal (3) of sheath of cable (B) to control support (2) and withdraw spiral at the end of cable from lever (4)
- release (by pulling upward) the other end of the sheath of cable (B) from metal clip (5) inserted in block (6) press-fitted to left side surface of heater-distributor assembly fan assembly;
- withwraw spiral from the other end of the cable from the cylindrical ridge on air mixer flap lever (7).

- unscrew screw (8) that fastens terminal (9) of sheath of cable (C) to control support and withdraw spiral at the end of cable from lever (10);
- release (by pulling upward) the other end of the sheath of cable (C) from metal clip (11) inserted in block (12) press-fitted to left side surface of heater-distributor assembly fan assembly;
- withwraw spiral from the other end of the cable (C) from the cylindrical ridge (13) on rack operating distribution flaps.




To refit the new cables (B and C) carry out removal operations in reverse order, noting that the end of the sheath without the terminal must be inserted in metal clips (5 and 11 respectively) so that the mixer and distribution flaps can move through their entire travel

NOTE To correct position of sheaths of cables (B and C) the instrument facia need not be removed because the repair can be carried by working from the bottom right in the middle.


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


PASSENGER COMPARTMENT VENTILA-TION FAN SPEED SELECTOR


Dismantling and rebuilding

- undo the two screws indicated by arrows in the second figure on the left on the previous page that fasten passenger compartment ventilation fan speed selector (2) to control assembly;
- disconnect connector (9) from control support (3) and release wiring (16) for symbol light bulbs after pushing the two bulb holders (13) inside.

Levers (7 and 8 in figure on previous page) are fitted to toothed shanks (14) of knobs (15) so that the triangle on parts (7 and 8) is located between the two teeth of the shank marked by two raised dots (see detail at bottom left of previous page).

To check the correct position of the two parts above, remove the two discs (indicated by letter **a** in the second figure on the left on the previous page) retaining levers (7 and 8) in position on toothed shanks (14) of knobs (15).

NOTE To replace the glass bulbs (indicated by small arrows in the bottom right hand figure on the previous page), neither the facia or the control support need be removed. Simply remove the front panel from the support and then remove the bulb or bulbs to be changed.








 drain engine cooling system, then loosen clips (arrowed) and disconnect the two pipes (1) from heater radiator input and output ducts (2 in figure at bottom of previous page) that protrude through the dashboard (bulkhead between passenger compartment and engine bay) into the rear of the engine bay;






- working from the rear of the engine bay, unscrew plastic discs (3) and underlying nuts that fasten distributor heater inside passenger compartment to dashboard;
- working from inside the passenger compartment, disconnect electrical lead connectors from terminal (4) of distributor heater assembly wiring;
- for vehicles with top tunnel trim only, unscrew screw retaining middle of bracket joining the two pipes carrying air to the front side outlets on the above trim to the vehicle floorpan;

- release the two pipes above from the bottom of the distributor heater unit;
- unscrew the nuts arrowed in the top right figure that retain the top of the above assembly to the body;
- remove the distributor heater assembly from the passenger compartment.

The distributor heater assembly consists in essence of fan unit (A) to which distributor heater unit (C) is connected via duct (B).


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
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
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Details of bottom fan unit case half






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Detail of top fan unit case half







Detail of air intake flap and operating lever

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
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
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




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
Detail of right hand case half


View of left hand case half without square levers controlling flaps

To remove the passenger compartment ventilation fan, simply undo bottom part of instrument facia (indicated by arrow in top figure) and unscrew screws (1) that fasten base (2) to the bottom part of distributor heater assembly. Then withdraw connector (3) and disconnect from supply leads.


Detail showing fastening of top right and side of condenser to coolant and engine oil radiators


Carry out the following operations:

- remove windscreen wiper arms (1) after removing plugs and unscrewing nuts retaining them to operating shafts;
- unscrew screws (part indicated by arrows in top figure) that fasten transverse guard (2) of compartment under windscreen glass to body;
- remove guard (2) from seat and bend to release from engine bay cover hinges;
- working from right hand side of bay under windscreen glass, lift tabs (arrowed) of frame of antipollen filter assembly (3) in order to release from underlying support (5);
- pull antipollen filter assembly (3) out to remove from seat above support (5).

The antipollen filter assembly (3) consists of a plastic frame to which is fitted filter element and filter element is connected to frame by a flexible clip (indicated by arrow).

The above frame is moulded to reflect the form of the opening (which communicates with fan inlet duct of evaporator - heater - distributor assembly) on dashboard (bulkhead between engine and passenger compartment).

The filter element is rectangular and consists of a special folded sheet.
